### Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

DAODAS is purchasing advertising space through fourteen movie theatres throughout the state to run banner ads for the "Just One Fake Pill Can Kill" Campaign. This campaign warns people of the dangers of fentanyl-laced pills. Ads air prior to the feature presentation and drive viewers to the "Just Plain Killers" website (Justplainkillers.com) where they can learn more information related to the dangers of fentanyl, the availability of overdose reverasl medication such as naloxone, signs and symptoms of an overdose, etc. Ads will be airing on 177 screens across the state during the timeframe stated above.

Open Conversation SC (Opencoversationsc.com) is a new DAODAS campaign launched in November 2023. The purpose of the educational campaign is to encourage parents to have short, frequent conversations with their children to talk with them about alcohol, tobacco and other drugs to keep them healthy and safe. The 30-second PSA spots that will air on social media and streaming services will drive citizens to the website that includes conversation starters/games, facts about alcohol and other drugs, age-appropriate conversation starters, etc. The website also displays video vignettes (that are also housed on the DAODAS YouTube channel) demonstrating how to start a conversation and tips on keeping the conversations going.
